

Missing Peoples

A supplement to Merriam-Webster's
Collegiate Dictionary, Eleventh Edition

Many dictionaries do not include the names of countries in the main body of the dictionary, but in a separate section at the end. What is included are the nouns that name the nationalities of the inhabitants of places. For example 'Spain' would be not be included, but the noun/nationality 'Spanish' would be. Merriam-Webster's Collegiate Dictionary uses this method of lexicography, but includes only 83 out of a list of 222 nationalities (complete list on page 34).

This volume lists the 139 nationalities of the missing peoples.

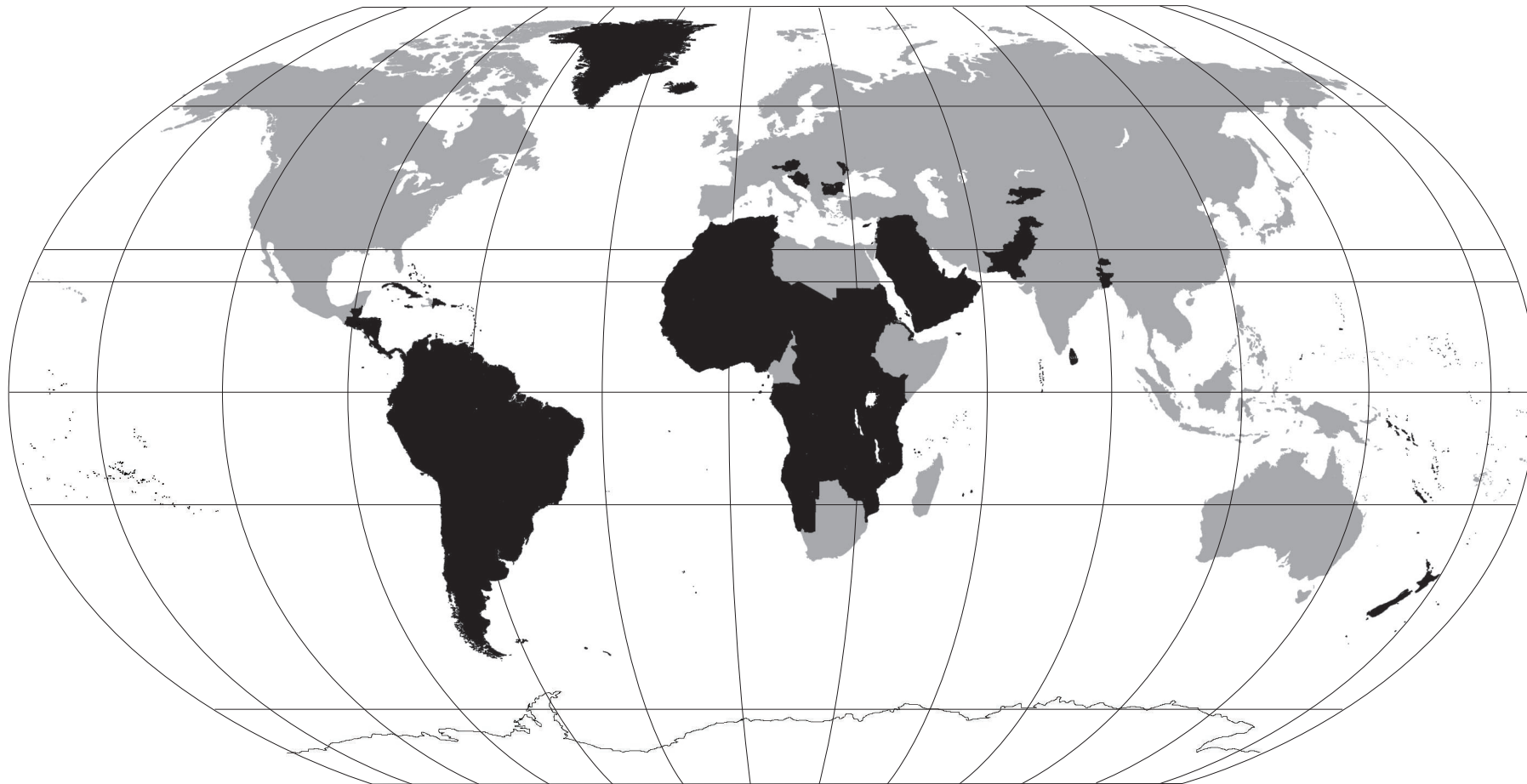
